- Comparison of the internet-usage between two or more as nation defined in the (Northern) European context
- The influence/importance of an open web-culture for the scientific discourse
- representation of history in the internet

Regarding the formal expectations:

Please send your abstract first. It shouldn't be longer than one page. The deadline for abstracts is 14 days from today.

We publish in German and English, please choose one of these languages to write.

Preferably, articles should not exceed 40,000 characters (including whitespace). The outline should have no more than three levels. Additionally, please enclose a short summary of your article (maximum 1,000 characters) in German and/or English, as well as some information about your field of science and vita (one or two sentences).

We operate with an anonymous peer-review-process, which means before your article comes into consideration for a publication two external reviewers evaluate your manuscript.

In case you are interested in publishing some of your work at NORDEUROPAforum, we are very pleased.
